

Instructions for Student Presentations

INFOST 340

Requirements

1. Presentations should be 3 to 5 minutes long.
2. You should have 3 to 5 slides that help to drive your presentation (submit to the “Slides for Student Presentation” dropbox).
3. You should address 3 questions:
 - Who are your stakeholders (describe them)? Pay particular attention to insights that you have regarding the stakeholder that other students may not share.
 - What are some interesting details of your proposed solution? Pay particular attention to features that you have included that other students may not have included in their solution.
 - How is systems analysis different from (or the same as) what you had expected? Pay particular attention to how your experience may have been different from that of other students based upon your unique background or point of view.

Procedures

1. I will call each presenter in alphabetical order.
2. I will help get the slides open from the dropbox and ready for presenting.
3. I will set a clock so that you can see how you are doing on time.
4. I will turn the floor over to you to make your presentation.
5. If anyone is not ready in their time slot, then they will be moved to the end of the presentation sequence for that day.

Grading

This presentation will count toward your class participation grade. Students who do not demonstrate a good faith effort at making a presentation will receive lower class participation grades.
