XSLT Stylesheet

Must include an xsl:output element.

xsl:output element must include the options demonstrated in the tutorial video.

Must include a template rule that matches on the document root node ("/").

Must use navigational stylesheet design pattern.

Must provide for sorted output.

Must include a footer on each page that includes both document title and page number.

Technique (13 available content points)

Requirements

Must use techniques demonstrated in the tutorial video.

Must be well-formed and valid.

Must iterate of museum elements using <xsl:for-each>.

Must use the <xsl:if> element to prevent empty <fo:block> elements (or <fo:block> elements that include titles without data) from being generated for optional elements that are not present in the instance document.

Must provide for sorting of museums data using the <xsl:sort> element.

Must prevent the spanning of data for a single museum over a page break by using the keep-together attribute.

Must use <xsl:text> element to insert text into output where appropriate.

Must use a named <xsl:template> element to contain the footer code.

Must control page size and margins in the <fo:simple-page-master> element.

Must define a region for the footer content using the <fo:region-after> element.

Must define the footer content using the <fo:static-content> element.

Must provide layout for the footer using the <fo:table> element.

Must generate page numbers using the <fo:page-number> element.

Must NOT show museum entries being spread across page breaks.

Footer must be present.

Footer must contain document title.

Footer must contain a proper page number.

Technique (13 available content points)

Requirements

Must NOT include blank lines when optional sub-elements are missing from the input.

Must NOT include "titles without data" when optional sub-elements are missing from the input.

Must NOT include pages with too many blank lines at the bottom. Hint, this symptom results from the XSLT code having inserted blank <fo:block> elements into the output document for optional elements that are not present in the instance document.

Footer must be properly situated on the page.

Footer must be properly formatted.
