### **Assignment**

This deliverable is the site itself. I will be grading it based upon my experience while visiting the site and other information from viewing the Site Demo Video.

### **Expectations**

When grading the delivered site, I will consider the following:

#### *Functionality*

The site is expected to address the information needs of a new project management practitioner in some professional discipline (ie: public libraries, archives, humanities research data centers, data science, etc.). The site should provide relevant resources using an effective user interface.

#### *Site Design*

The site design should reflect the good practices taught at the Illinois iSchool. This includes both information architecture and usability.

#### *Content*

The content should reflect the good practices taught at the Illinois iSchool regarding resource selection, resource presentation, intellectual property rights, and other similar issues.

#### *Testing*

The system must be tested effectively.

#### *Documentation*

The Agile approach to documentation is minimalistic. Nevertheless, any documentation needed by the users or maintainers of the system should be created in a professional manner and demonstrated with the system.

#### *Training*

The Agile approach to training is also minimalistic. Nevertheless, any training needed by the users or maintainers of the system should be created in a professional manner and demonstrated with the system.
